The CREW nominator should make a check payable to "The CREW of the SS Fellowship" (for an amount of \$100 or more but may consider less), which accompanies the nomination of a new Mate to the CREW. This has been customary since the inception of The CREW of the SS Fellowship. NOTE: Remember one cannot buy ones way into the CREW of the SS Fellowship and must be nominated by a current Mate. The accompanying check must be from the nominator, not the nominee.
